SchoolComms (Schoolgateway)

Have you registered on the schoolgateway?

The school will be using the schoolgateway as a means to communicate with parents. Letters and other information will be sent out primarily by email so please ensure that the office has your correct email address. Text messaging will be used for contacting parents with reminders or urgent message regarding the school. We will continue to contact parents directly by telephone in the case of individual concerns (if your child is unwell for example). Dinner money payments and club payments can ONLY be made online- please register and start using this facility. For further help please ask in the school office.

Open Evenings

Open evening for all classes will be on Wednesday 3rd and 17th October 2018. Please book your appointment by using the sign up sheets in the office area of Cadogan Gardens and just inside the entrance of Sedding Street from Monday 17th September. We hope all parents will be able to attend.

Dinner Money

Dinner money will be £2.50 per day / £12.50 per week from Wednesday 5th September 2018.

All dinner money for children in the nursery and years 3-6 should be paid on the schoolgateway and must be in credit for the week ahead. Please contact the school office if you would like to check if your child is entitled to free school meals.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is available every morning in our Sedding Street building from 8.00am – no booking necessary. The charge is £1.50 per day. This can be paid in advance or on the day. If your child does not attend, you will not be charged.

All club forms must be returned to the school office AFTER payment is made on the school gateway. From this term, all club payments will be online only in advance of the start date.
