Re: Head Teacher Appointment

As you know for nearly two years, Mrs Lloyd Wright has been leading the schools as Acting Head Teacher whilst the Governors of the school planned for a permanent Head Teacher. This process has taken longer than originally envisaged. Over the last year the school and Mrs Lloyd Wright have been further supported by Mrs Hawkins who has given her time in a consultative role.

I am now able to update you on the new permanent leadership arrangements following consultation with the Local Authority and London Diocesan Board for Schools as well as with the Governors of Christ Church School. They are pleased to welcome Mrs Hawkins and Mrs Lloyd Wright into their new roles at Holy Trinity School. We are also grateful that we have used the links formed through the Chelsea Deanery Schools Partnership to allow us to take up this opportunity. With the permanent leadership in place, the Governors can further focus on the success of the school.
