Breakfast Club

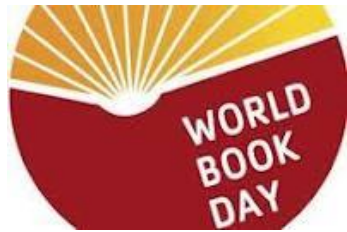
