On the 26th of September 2018, we met the fantastic author S.F. Said. His talk was about how he became an author with 91 rejections and how he was determined to write his book. After a publisher finally accepted his script, his first book took him five years to write. The novel Varjak Paw was based on his kitten whom he carefully observed. That novel won the 2003 Nestle Smarties Book Prize.

Said's 2nd book The Outlaw Varjak Paw took him a much shorter time to write - three years. It was based on Varjak, the karate cat, being an adult and being an outlaw, trying to be found and captured. This novel won the 2007 Blue Peter Book of the Year.

Said's 3rd book Phoenix was a longer novel, which took him 7 years to write. It was about a boy who wanted to reach out for the stars.

Everyone agreed that the event was a great success and both children and adults were really inspired!
