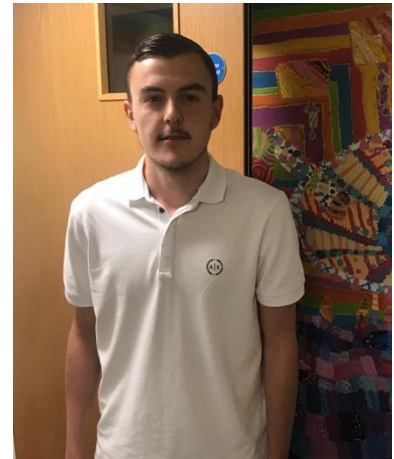
**Miss Bingley, Year 1:**
